The Ph.D. Dissertation Award will recognize research excellence and contribution to the profession by a doctoral candidate in the area of aquaculture economics. The recipients of the award will receive an honorarium of \$1,000 and reimbursement of \$500 for travel to attend a professional aquaculture meeting*.

Nomination requirements:

- Eligible for nomination are final dissertations with a completion date during calendar year 2009.
- A letter of nomination from the department head (or chair) where the dissertation was completed. The letter should state the nominee's name, title of the dissertation, adviser's name, name of the institution, and a brief outline of the merits of the research.
- Three (3) copies of the dissertation. Copies should be double-sided and spiral bound. Upon request, copies will be returned. If return is desired, a return address should be provided.
- Deadline for receipt of entries for dissertations completed in 2009 is January 15 2010.
