Nomination requirements:

- Eligible for nomination are final M.S. theses with a completion date during calendar year 2009.
- A letter of nomination from the department head (or chair) where the thesis was completed. The letter should state the nominee's name, title of the thesis, adviser's name, name of the institution, and a brief outline of the merits of the work.
- Three (3) copies of the thesis. Copies should be double-sided and spiral bound. Upon request, copies will be returned. If return is desired, a return address must be provided.
- Deadline for receipt of entries for theses completed in 2009 is January 15 2010.
